Elected officials to get 9% raises

Supervisors nix Compensation Board's recommendation of 20% pay hikes

The smart aleck who attended Monday's Chickasaw County Board of Supervisors meeting might have said that "at least, it was something besides the ambulance that put the board behind schedule."

And that smart aleck would not be wrong as supervisors spent almost

an hour discussing the county's Compensation Board recommendation to give all elected officials a 20 percent raise.

That recommendation had been made by a 5-2 vote during the board's annual meeting that took place on Dec. 7.

But almost from the start, there appeared to be little appetite from supervisors to accept the recommen-

dation of the Comp Board, despite a spirited push by New Hampton attorney Mike Kennedy.

"All of us have got to do something," Kennedy said, "... to fill important slots. ... Sooner or later, we have to recognize the worth of the people in this building and compensate them accordingly."

But Supervisor Jake Hackman almost immediately expressed con-

cerns, saying the county could not afford the pay raises, especially in light of rumors that the Legislature is considering freezing county property taxes for two years.

In the end, supervisors agreed to cut the Compensation Board recommendation by 55 percent; in other words, it approved on a 3-1 vote to raise elected

official salaries by 9 percent. Supervisor Tim Zoll voted cast the lone dissenting vote, but Hackman said he wanted his vote as

NEIC will remain the same for one more school year

Mediation process leads to deal to allow W-SR to 'voluntarily' leave the league after 2023-24

A deal has been struck, one that will see Waverly-Shell Rock leave the Northeast Iowa Conference a year later than expected.

New Hampton Superintendent Jay Jurrens announced last week and informed the School Board on Monday night that the six current NEIC schools had reached a compromise agreement after going through a mediation process with the Iowa Department of Education that will allow Waverly-Shell Rock to remain in the conference during the 2023-24 school year.

The other five schools — New Hampton, Charles City, Crestwood, Decorah and Waukon — voted last year to remove the Go-Hawks from the conference, effective at the end of this school year.

Jurrens told board members that they would vote on the mediation agreement during their January board meeting but that he felt the agreement was a positive one for the conference.

"I think the positive is that when you have an agreement where they will voluntarily leave the conference," he said, "that means that it's less likely that the state will 'place' them back with us."

The NEIC schools that voted in effect to kick Waverly-Shell Rock out of the NEIC did so because W-SR's enrollment is by far the largest in the conference and because it was difficult to recruit new members while the Go-Hawks were in the league.

Under the agreement reached last week —

School, Little Sprouts partnership derailed by remodeling costs

The idea seemed like a no-brainer, but it turns out the costs to remodel a pair of classrooms at the elementary school have put the brakes on New Hampton Community Schools partnering with Little Sprouts Daycare to provide before-school, after-school, "Wednesday Care" and non-school daycare for elementary students.

During a School Board meeting in November, Superintendent Jay Jurrens broached the subject, and board members

Board of Supervisors, EMS director reach tentative contract agreement

County leaders direct HR attorney to make changes that will allow Knutson to receive holiday pay but not sick pay or vacation

The Chickasaw County Board of Supervisors and the director of the new county-owned ambulance service reached a tentative contract agreement during a meeting held Monday, 12 days before Chickasaw County EMS is scheduled to begin service.

Joel Knutson was hired this fall

and is currently working to set up the service that will serve rural residents of the county and six cities — New Hampton, Bassett, Frederickburg, Ionia, Lawler and North Washington.

But a contract that will employ Knutson as a part-time director has yet to be finalized. During a Dec. 12 meeting, Knutson and supervisors couldn't reach an agreement on a number of items — including vacation time, sick

pay and holiday pay.

When supervisors agreed to hire Knutson, they offered the longtime advanced paramedic a salary of \$60,000 for working 60 hours every two-week pay period, plus \$31 per hour for any extra shifts Knutson needed to work.

On Monday, Knutson offered to forego vacation and sick time in exchange for receiving time-and-a-half

pay if he worked as a paramedic on county holidays.

"I'm not thrilled with conceding that," he said, "but if that is what it takes to get this moving through ... so be it."

He told supervisors that, as director, he expects paramedics to work at least one holiday a year and added that with nine paramedics currently on staff, he would be working a holiday or two.

Foster Grandparents looking for volunteers in Chickasaw County

Jennifer Lantz will borrow a page — well, actually a line — from Uncle Sam.

She wants you to become a grandparent, as in joining the Foster Grandparents program that she heads up.

"We're really looking to get more people involved in Chickasaw County," said the director of the program that is based in Charles City but offers services in Floyd, Cerro Gordo, Mitchell and Chickasaw counties.

"I think if you talk to any of our [current] grandparents, they'll tell you that it's such a rewarding experience," Lantz said. "No scratch that, I know they will tell you that it's a program that is not only an awesome experience for kids but for them, too."

Foster Grandparents staff

and volunteers got an update on the program, talked about their successes, and enjoyed bingo, lunch and door prizes at their annual Winter Appreciation Dinner, held last week at St. John Evangelical Lutheran Church in Charles City.

But as Lantz put it, "there's always room for more." As in volunteers.

The first thing to know is that to be in the program, you don't have to be a grandparent. Volunteers just have to be 55 or older and have a desire to work with children at area schools and daycares.

"We have people go into schools and help kids with reading, math, any of the academic needs they might have," Lantz said.

"Some of our grandparents go to lunch, socialize with the kids, just let them know they have a friend who's willing to be there for them. ... We have oth-

ers, at the daycares, that rock babies all day long."

And the program director said it's really up to the grandparents to decide their schedule.

"They can work anywhere from five to 40 hours a week," she said. "We're willing to work

with people."

'Come, Lord Jesus'

Advent season is all about preparing for the arrival of our Savior

The church season of Advent includes the four Sundays leading up to Christmas. It is a time of expectancy and preparation for the celebration of the birth of Jesus but also waiting for the second coming of Jesus.

As we celebrate the birth of Jesus, using that sense of fulfillment to fuel our hope for the second coming, strengthens us to work for the kingdom of God now as followers of Christ.

The word "Advent" comes from the Latin word "adventus" which means "a coming, approach, arrival." When we expect guests to arrive, we turn on the lights; we anticipate their arrival by preparing, and

welcome them with joy.

During Advent, part of the preparation for the coming of Jesus Christ, Savior, Messiah, Immanuel, Lord, King of Kings, is represented by four candles positioned in a circular pattern within an Advent wreath.

The circular pattern of the Advent wreath symbolizes God's infinite and never-ending love for us. The wreath is made of evergreen leaves.

The four candles on the wreath represent the four Sundays of Advent and symbolize hope, peace, joy, and love.

The Hope, or Prophecy, candle is purple is lit the first week which leads us to anticipate the birth of Christ.

The Peace, or Bethlehem, candle is also purple. Lit the second week, it reminds us of Mary and Joseph's journey from Nazareth to Bethlehem before Mary gave birth to Jesus.

The Joy, or Shepherd's, candle is pink to remind us of the joyful anticipation of the shepherds who journeyed to see Jesus in Bethlehem.

The fourth candle is the Love, or Angel's, candle. This candle is purple and represents the ultimate love of God that He sent His only Son for us.

There is a larger fifth candle placed in the center and is lit on Christmas Eve to represent the birth of Jesus.


Melvin Joseph was born on Aug. 11, 1937, to Grant C. and Edith (Mlady) Pacovsky in Glenwood, Minnesota.


Another successful Lettermen's Club Canned Food Drive

As part of the preliminary exam, each contestant must write an essay of about a thousand words on the subject, "My Science Project."

NH bowled its last matchup before Christmas break at Lilac Lanes in West Union against North Fayette Valley on Tuesday.





second-chance baskets, put-backs, in that first quarter, but they fought back. To make that a two-possession game, I think it shows how bought in our girls are."

But it was the effort that he saw Friday night against a 6-1 Decorah team that had Leichtman excited for the rest of the season.

Chickasaws improve but can't get a 'W'

New Hampton girls battle against NEIC rivals as top-notch schedule continues

If there is one word to describe the early part of the 2022-23 girls basketball schedule, it would have to be grueling.

So while Chickasaw coach David Leichtman may not like his team's 1-6 record, he knows that the Chickasaws' first-third-of-the-season slate has been akin to New Hampton attending the school of hard knocks.

Don't believe us? Well, consider this: After falling to Waukon 68-62 and Decorah 54-40 last week, the Chickasaws' opponents thus far into the season have a combined record of 36-11.

"We're getting better every single game," Leichtman said after his team gave Decorah, Class 4A's sixth-ranked squad, a tussle early before a tough third quarter doomed the Chickasaws. "It doesn't matter who we're playing, our girls have bought in. We approach

So yes, the Chickasaws were 1-6 heading into the final week of the 2022 portion of their schedule, but as far as their coach is concerned New Hampton has come miles in a month.

Take last week, for example. The Chickasaws overcame a slow start — they trailed 26-13 after the first quarter — to give Waukon a battle and did so despite losing its star, Carlee Rochford, to fouls with more than three minutes to play.

Rochford was brilliant, scoring 30 points, before fouling out, and the Chickasaws also got solid play from Taylor Ries, who had 10 points and the Rosonkes — Elaina and Braelyn — who combined for 14 points and 12 rebounds.


